BEARMAN BEND VINEYARD
PINOT NOIR

A classic cool-climate vintage delivered outstanding wines and a return to a typical October harvest in the Anderson Valley. A cold, wet winter was marked by abundant rainfall, pushing budbreak later than usual and setting a slow, deliberate pace for the growing season. Mild spring and summer temperatures allowed for steady vine development and when warmth arrived in late summer, the well-hydrated vines responded with vibrant, balanced fruit. A mix of sunny days and scattered rain in early fall created ideal ripening conditions and fruit from blocks 14, 9, 7 and 13B was harvested in early October at peak maturity.

This single-vineyard bottling is crafted exclusively from heritage Pinot Noir selections—Swan, Mt. Eden, Calera and a unique massale selection—each contributing distinct character and depth. The wine opens with lifted aromatics of wild strawberry and rose petal. On the palate, it is bright and expressive, offering a lively core of red fruit layered with notes of bramble, tea leaf and subtle spice. The tannins are fine and well-structured, providing an elegant framework that carries the wine through a long mineral-laced finish. The 2023 Bearman Bend Vineyard Pinot Noir is a striking expression of its site and season—poised, energetic and built to evolve with time in glass and cellar.
