WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Our 2013 Monument Tree Vineyard Pinot Noir from the Anderson Valley is a captivating and lively wine that displays the delicate balance between perfumed fresh fruits, fresh acidity and savory umami that typifies western Anderson Valley. The wine has a red-rose color with purple highlights and a nose of fresh lychee, nutmeg, redwood bark and a hint of blood orange. It has a vibrant attack and ideal acid balance that brings freshness to its remarkable depth and complexity.

NOTES FROM THE VINEYARD

The 2013 California growing season will be remembered as extremely dry, but in Anderson Valley's unique climate it began with a cool, wet spring which persisted until mid-May. From that point in the season through harvest, the conditions were unusually dry, warm and fog-free. These conditions intensified the berry characters of this exquisite estate owned gem in the Deep End of Anderson Valley.
