APPEARANCE

Ruby with purple rim

AROMAS

Bing cherry and plum with notes of cardamom and spruce tips

PALATE

Bramble, raspberry and wild forest fruit

MOUTHFEEL

Full-bodied yet ethereal with round, silky tannins

FINISH

Cranberry and tart red fruit

AGEABILITY

7-9 years

PAIRING

Citrus-brined pork chops

NOTES FROM THE VINEYARD

Near the top of Oregon's famed Red Hills of Dundee, Prince Hill Vineyard proudly sits facing southeast. Its vines maximize every bit of sunshine during the region's short, but dry, growing season, and the vineyard's elevation protects it from excess heat, allowing for slower, more even ripening. Overall, 2017 was temperate. We saw consistent ripening throughout the vineyard, which allowed us to hand-pick blocks with some measure of leisure. The resulting wine captures this steadiness of the vintage—graceful and lithe with density and structure.
